

Privacy Statement

Condon Engineering are committed to protecting your privacy at all times and in compliance with legal regulations. This Privacy Policy sets out how we use and protect any information that you provide to Condon Engineering when you use our website.

Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website; you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

What is personal data?

Personal data means all data that can provide information about an identifiable natural person. Condon Engineering processes your personal data because you are using our services and/or because you have provided us with this information.

Examples of personal data include:

How we use your information?

Condon Engineering will only keep your personal data as long as it is necessary to complete the purposes for which your data is collected, to represent the legitimate interests of Condon Engineering and as long as we are legally obliged to do so.

If you do not wish us to use your data in this way, please tick the relevant box situated on the form on which we collect your data.
- We may periodically send post or promotional emails about new products, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting.
- From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone, fax or mail. We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, modify or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your previously given consent to the data processing, if any, or object to the processing of your personal data by Condon Engineering.

To ensure that the request has actually been made by you, Condon Engineering can ask you for proof of identity. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, in any case within four weeks.

The removal of your personal data is only possible when the data is no longer relevant.

Officer. In addition, you have the option to submit a complaint to the national supervisory authority, the Data Protection Commissioner of Ireland.
